AN ACT

To amend chapter 217, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the establishment of a dump truck driver training program.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 217, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 217.1010, to read as follows:

217.1010. 1. The department shall establish and operate at its correctional 2 centers a dump truck driver training program to assist offenders in obtaining 3 commercial driver's licenses for employment as dump truck drivers upon discharge 4 from the department.

- The department shall coordinate with the Missouri Dump Truckers 6 Association or its successor association to develop a curriculum for the program that prepares drivers to operate dump trucks under real operating conditions. Training 8 shall include, but not be limited to, operating a dump truck on roadways, loading 9 materials into a dump truck, and dumping materials.
- 3. The department shall accept donations of equipment from the Missouri Dump 10 11 Truckers Association or its members. Such equipment shall be in road-worthy 12 condition and capable of passing all safety inspections. The department may request the 13 Missouri state highway patrol to perform inspections on equipment to confirm the condition of the equipment prior to donation. The highway patrol shall perform such inspections within seven business days of the request. Any equipment donated by the Missouri Dump Truckers Association may bear the logo or name of the association

making the donation or any member donating the equipment if requested by the association or member.

- 4. The department of transportation shall allow the department the right of first refusal for any equipment it is planning to surplus that would be beneficial for the operation of the dump truck driver training program.
- 5. The first training program established under this section shall be located at the Northeast Correctional Center. The department may establish additional locations for the program based on equipment donations and appropriations, and when vocational market forces deem such additional training sites necessary to meet market demand for additional dump truck drivers.
- 6. The department shall work in conjunction with the Missouri Dump Truckers
 Association to establish a method for marketing newly trained commercial driver's
 license holders to the dump truck industry upon an offender's discharge from the
 department.
