AN ACT

To amend chapter 273, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to dogs.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 273, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 273.195, to read as follows:

273.195. 1. **Nothing in this chapter shall be construed to limit in any manner the**
2 **authority of any village, town, or city, including any home rule city, to prohibit dogs from**
3 **running at large or to further control or regulate dogs within its boundaries; provided that,**
4 **no such ordinances, orders, policies, or regulations are specific to breed.**

5 2. **The general assembly hereby occupies and preempts the entire field of legislation**
6 **touching in any way the control or regulation of specific breeds of dogs to the complete**
7 **exclusion of any order, ordinance, policy, or regulation by any village, town, or city,**
8 **including any home rule city, in this state. Any existing or future orders, ordinances,**
9 **policies, or regulations in this field are hereby and shall be null and void.**
