AN ACT

To repeal section 40.490, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to rights of military servicemembers.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 40.490, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu 2 thereof, to be known as section 40.490, to read as follows:

40.490. 1. Members of the state military forces of this state who are ordered to active state duty by the governor, any Missouri employee who is a member of the National Guard of 2 another state and who is called into active state duty by the governor of that state, or any member 3 4 of any reserve component of the Armed Forces of the United States who is called to active duty shall, upon being relieved from such duty, be entitled to the same reemployment rights provided 5 by Title 38 of the United States Code, the Revised Statutes of Missouri, and all amendments 6 thereto. The attorney general shall enforce the reemployment rights contained in this section for 7 8 members of the state military forces who are ordered to active state duty by the governor. 9 2. Members of the Missouri National Guard who are called to active state duty by 10 the governor and any Missouri employees who are members of the National Guard of

another state and are called to active state duty by the governor of that state shall, upon
being relieved from such duty, be entitled to all rights and protections provided by the
Servicemembers Civil Relief Act, 50 U.S.C. Section 3901 et seq., and all amendments

15 **3.** The department of labor and industrial relations shall make available the 16 following notice that every employer shall post in a conspicuous place in each employment

17 establishment:

18 "If you are in the National Guard, you have certain protected employment and 19 reemployment rights, rights to freedom from discrimination, and the right to civil relief 20 under federal laws 38 U.S.C. 4301 et seq. (USERRA) and 50 U.S.C. 3901 et seq. (SCRA) 21 and under section 40.490, RSMo. If you feel that you have been discriminated against or 22 denied these rights because of your service in the National Guard, contact the Missouri 23 committee of the Employer Support of the Guard and Reserve (ESGR) at 573-638-9625." 24 4. Any member of the Missouri National Guard and any Missouri employee who 25 is a member of the National Guard of another state may bring suit in any court of 26 competent jurisdiction and appropriate venue if such individual believes that his or her 27 rights under this section have been violated. The attorney general may also bring suit 28 against an employer who violates the provisions of this section.
