AN ACT

To repeal section 184.353, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to museums.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 184.353, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 184.353, to read as follows:

184.353. 1. (1) The board of directors of any metropolitan zoological park and museum district, as established according to the provisions of sections 184.350 to 184.384, on behalf of the district may request the election officials of any city and county containing all or part of such district to submit the following described proposition to the qualified voters of such district at any general, primary or special election. Such election officials shall give legal notice at least sixty days prior to such general, primary or special election in at least two newspapers that such proposition shall be submitted at any general, primary or special election held for submission of the proposition.

(2) Such proposition shall be submitted to the voters in substantially the following form at such election:

Shall the Metropolitan Zoological Park and Museum District of the City of _____ and County of _____ be authorized to provide for a Botanical Garden Subdistrict and be authorized to provide the Botanical Garden Subdistrict with a tax rate not in excess of four cents on each \$100 of assessed valuation of taxable property within the district?

17 (3) In the event that a majority of all the voters voting on such proposition in such city
18 and a majority of voters voting on such proposition in such county cast "YES" votes on the
19 proposition, then the botanical garden subdistrict shall be deemed established and the tax rate,
20 as established by the board for such subdistrict, shall be deemed in full force and effect as of the
21 first day of the second month following the election. The results of the election shall be certified
22 by the election officials of such city and county, respectively, to the respective chief executive
23 officers of such city and county not less than thirty days after the day of the election. The cost
24 of the election shall be paid as provided by sections 115.063 and 115.065. In the event the
25 proposition shall fail to receive a majority of the "YES" votes in either the city or the county,
26 then the proposition shall not be resubmitted at any election held prior to the next general or
27 primary election in such city or county in the following year. Any such resubmission shall
28 subsequently comply with the provisions of sections 184.350 to 184.384.

29 (4) If the botanical garden subdistrict shall be established, then its commissioners, or any
30 person with whom its commissioners contract, may establish and charge fees for admission to
31 the premises of the botanical garden subdistrict, or to the premises of any person with whom its
32 commissioners contract, not to exceed one dollar for adults and fifty cents for children under
33 sixteen years of age. Any increase in the fees shall be presented prior to implementation for
34 approval or disapproval to the board of the metropolitan zoological park and museum district of
35 which the botanical garden subdistrict is a member.

36 2. (1) The board of directors of any metropolitan zoological park and museum district,
37 as established according to the provisions of sections 184.350 to 184.384, on behalf of the
38 district may request the election officials of any city and county containing all or part of such
39 district to submit the following described proposition to the qualified voters of such district at
40 any general, primary or special election. Such election officials shall give legal notice at least
41 sixty days prior to such general, primary or special election in at least two newspapers that such
42 proposition shall be submitted at any general, primary or special election held for submission of
43 the proposition.

44 (2) Such proposition shall be submitted to the voters in substantially the following form
45 at such election:

46 Shall the Metropolitan Zoological Park and Museum District of the City of
47 _____ and County of _____ be authorized to provide for a Transport Museum
48 Subdistrict and be authorized to provide the Transport Museum Subdistrict with
49 a tax rate not in excess of four cents on each \$100 of assessed valuation of
50 taxable property within the district?

52 (3) In the event that a majority of all the voters voting on such proposition in such city
53 and a majority of voters voting on such proposition in such county cast "YES" votes on the
54 proposition, then the transport museum subdistrict shall be deemed established and the tax rate,
55 as established by the board for such subdistrict, shall be deemed in full force and effect as of the
56 first day of the second month following the election. The results of the election shall be certified
57 by the election officials of such city and county, respectively, to the respective chief executive
58 officers of such city and county not less than thirty days after the day of the election. The cost
59 of the election shall be paid as provided by sections 115.063 and 115.065. In the event the
60 proposition shall fail to receive a majority of the "YES" votes in either the city or the county,
61 then the proposition shall not be resubmitted at any election held prior to the next general or
62 primary election in such city or county in the following year. Any such resubmission shall
63 subsequently comply with the provisions of sections 184.350 to 184.384.

64 (4) If the transport museum subdistrict shall be established, then its commissioners, or
65 any person with whom its commissioners contract, may establish and charge fees for admission
66 to the premises of the transport museum subdistrict, or to the premises of any person with whom
67 its commissioners contract, not to exceed one dollar for adults and fifty cents for children under
68 sixteen years of age. Any increase in the fees shall be presented prior to implementation for
69 approval or disapproval to the board of the metropolitan zoological park and museum district of
70 which the transport museum subdistrict is a member.

71 3. (1) The board of directors of any metropolitan zoological park and museum district,
72 as established according to the provisions of sections 184.350 to 184.384, on behalf of the
73 district may request the election officials of any city and county containing all or part of such
74 district to submit the following described proposition to the qualified voters of such district at
75 any general, primary or special election. Such election officials shall give legal notice at least
76 sixty days prior to such general, primary or special election in at least two newspapers that such
77 proposition shall be submitted at any general, primary or special election held for submission of
78 the proposition.

79 (2) Such proposition shall be submitted to the voters in substantially the following form
80 at such election:

83 History Museum Subdistrict and be authorized to provide the Missouri History

87 (3) In the event that a majority of all the voters voting on such proposition in such city
88 and a majority of voters voting on such proposition in such county cast "YES" votes on the
89 proposition, then the Missouri history museum subdistrict shall be deemed established and the
90 tax rate, as established by the board for such subdistrict, shall be deemed in full force and effect
91 as of the first day of the second month following the election. The results of the election shall
92 be certified by the election officials of such city and county, respectively, to the respective chief
93 executive officers of such city and county not less than thirty days after the day of the election.
94 The cost of the election shall be paid as provided by sections 115.063 and 115.065. In the event
95 the proposition shall fail to receive a majority of the "YES" votes in either the city or the county,
96 then the proposition shall not be resubmitted at any election held prior to the next general or

99 4. (1) The board of directors of any metropolitan zoological park and museum district,

102 district to submit the following described proposition to the qualified voters of such district at
103 any general, primary or special election. Such election officials shall give legal notice at least
104 sixty days prior to such general, primary or special election in at least two newspapers that such
105 proposition shall be submitted at any general, primary or special election held for submission of
106 the proposition.

107 (2) Such proposition shall be submitted to the voters in substantially the following form
108 at such election:

109 Shall the Metropolitan Zoological Park and Museum District of the City of
110 _____ and County of _____ be authorized to provide for a Symphony
111 Orchestra Subdistrict and be authorized to provide the Symphony Orchestra
112 Subdistrict with a tax rate not in excess of four cents on each \$100 of assessed
113 valuation of taxable property within the district?

115 (3) In the event that a majority of all the voters voting on such proposition in such city
116 and a majority of voters voting on such proposition in such county cast "YES" votes on the
117 proposition, then the symphony orchestra subdistrict shall be deemed established and the tax rate,
118 as established by the board for such subdistrict, shall be deemed in full force and effect as of the
119 first day of the second month following the election. The results of the election shall be certified
120 by the election officials of such city and county not less than thirty days after the day of election.
121 The cost of the election shall be paid as provided by sections 115.063 and 115.065. In the event
122 the proposition shall fail to receive a majority of the "YES" votes in either the city or the county,

123 then the proposition shall not be resubmitted at any election held prior to the next general or
124 primary **election** in such city or county in the following year. Any such resubmission shall
125 subsequently comply with the provisions of sections 184.350 to 184.384.

126 (4) If the symphony orchestra subdistrict shall be established, then its commissioners,
127 or any person with whom its commissioners contract, may charge such prices from time to time
128 for tickets for performances conducted under the auspices of the subdistrict or as they or such
129 person deem proper; provided, however, that no fewer than fifty tickets for each such
130 performance conducted at the principal concert hall of such subdistrict or such person shall be
131 made available without charge for distribution to members of the general public and no fewer
132 than fifty tickets shall be made available without charge for distribution to students in public and
133 private elementary, secondary schools and colleges and universities in the metropolitan
134 zoological park and museum district and all performances of the symphony orchestra conducted
135 at the principal concert hall of the symphony orchestra within the district shall be offered for
136 broadcast live on a public or commercial AM or FM radio station located in and generally
137 receivable in the district or on a public or commercial broadcast television station located in or
138 generally receivable in the district. The symphony orchestra subdistrict shall institute a fully
139 staffed educational music appreciation program to benefit all of the citizens of the taxing district
140 at a nominal charge.

141 (5) Immediately following the effective date of the symphony orchestra subdistrict tax
142 rate any person receiving funds from said tax rate shall become ineligible for program assistance
143 funding from the Missouri state council on the arts.

144 5. The board of directors of any metropolitan zoological park and museum district, as
145 established according to the provisions of sections 184.350 to 184.384, on behalf of the district
146 may request the election officials of any city and county containing all or part of such district to
147 submit the following described proposition to the qualified voters of such district at any general,
148 primary or special election. Such election officials shall give legal notice at least sixty days prior
149 to such general, primary or special election in at least two newspapers that such proposition shall
150 be submitted at any general, primary or special election held for submission of the proposition.
151 Such proposition shall be submitted to the voters in substantially the following form at such
152 election:

153 Shall a Recreational and Amateur Sports Subdistrict be authorized and provided
154 for by the Metropolitan Zoological Park and Museum District of the City of
155 _____ and the County of _____ and such subdistrict be authorized to establish
156 a tax rate not in excess of four cents on each \$100 of assessed valuation of
157 taxable property within the district for a period not to exceed nine years?

159 In the event that a majority of all the voters voting on such proposition in such city and a
160 majority of voters voting on such proposition in such county cast "YES" votes on the
161 proposition, then the recreation and amateur sports subdistrict shall be deemed established and
162 the tax rate, as established by the board for such subdistrict, shall be deemed in full force and
163 effect as of the first day of the second month following the election for a period not to exceed
164 nine years. The results of the election shall be certified by the election officials of such city and
165 county, respectively, to the respective chief executive officers of such city and county not less
166 than thirty days after the day of the election. The cost of the election shall be paid as provided
167 by sections 115.063 and 115.065. In the event the proposition shall fail to receive a majority of
168 the "YES" votes in either the city or the county, then the proposition shall not be resubmitted at
169 any election held prior to the next general or primary or special election in such city or county
170 in the following year. Any such resubmission shall subsequently comply with the provisions of
171 sections 184.350 to 184.384.

172 6. (1) **At the general election to be held on November 8, 2022, and at any other time**
173 the board of directors of any metropolitan zoological park and museum district, as established
174 according to the provisions of sections 184.350 to 184.384, on behalf of the district may request,
175 the election officials of any city and county containing all or part of such district ~~to~~ **shall** submit
176 the following described proposition to the qualified voters of such district at any general,
177 primary, or special election. Such election officials shall give legal notice at least sixty days
178 prior to such general, primary, or special election in at least two newspapers that such
179 proposition shall be submitted at any general, primary, or special election held for submission
180 of the proposition.

181 (2) Such proposition shall be submitted to the voters in substantially the following form
182 at such election:

183 Shall the Metropolitan Zoological Park and Museum District of the City of
184 _____ and County of _____ be authorized to provide for an African-American
185 History Museum and Cultural Subdistrict and be authorized to provide the
186 African-American history museum and cultural subdistrict with a tax rate not in
187 excess of four cents on each \$100 of assessed valuation of taxable property
188 within the district?

191 and a majority of voters voting on such proposition in such county cast "YES" votes on the

194 full force and effect as of the first day of the second month following the election. The results

195 of the election shall be certified by the election officials of such city and county, respectively,

198 and 115.065. In the event the proposition shall fail to receive a majority of the "YES" votes in
199 either the city or the county, then the proposition shall not be resubmitted at any election held

201 such resubmission shall subsequently comply with the provisions of sections 184.350 to 184.384.

202 (4) If the African-American history museum and cultural subdistrict shall be established,
203 then its commissioners, or any person with whom its commissioners contract, may establish and
204 charge fees for admission to the premises of the African-American history museum and cultural
205 subdistrict, or to the premises of any person with whom its commissioners contract, not to
206 exceed one dollar for adults and fifty cents for children under sixteen years of age. Any increase
207 in the fees shall be presented prior to implementation for approval or disapproval to the board
208 of the metropolitan zoological park and museum district of which the African-American history
209 museum and cultural subdistrict is a member.
