AN ACT

To repeal section 170.231, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to inspection of instructional materials.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 170.231, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 170.231, to read as follows:

170.231. **1.** The school board of each school district shall provide that all public school instructional material intended for use in connection with any public school classroom instruction, or any public school research or experimentation program or project, shall be available for inspection by any person. **The requested information shall be provided in a timely manner but in no case later than forty-five days after the date of the request. If such person is a resident of the school district, the requested information shall be provided at no charge.**

2. For the purpose of this section, "classroom instruction" shall mean any public school instruction involving teachers and students or peers and students; "research or experimentation program or project" shall mean any public school research or experimentation program or project designed to explore or develop new and unproven teaching methods and techniques.
