AN ACT

To amend chapter 195, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the controlled substance abuse prevention fund.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 195, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 195.430, to read as follows:

3 **195.430. 1. There is hereby established in the state treasury the “Controlled**
4 **Substance Abuse Prevention Fund”, which shall consist of moneys appropriated by the**
5 **general assembly, not to exceed the amount of fees collected by the department of health**
6 **and senior services for the issuance of registrations to manufacture, distribute, or dispense**
7 **controlled substances. The state treasurer shall be custodian of the fund. In accordance**
8 **with sections 30.170 and 30.180, the state treasurer may approve disbursements. The fund**
9 **shall be a dedicated fund and moneys in the fund shall be used solely for the operation,**
10 **regulation, enforcement, and educational activities of the bureau of narcotics and**
11 **dangerous drugs. The state treasurer shall invest moneys in the fund in the same manner**
12 **as other funds are invested. Any interest and moneys earned on such investments shall be**
13 **credited to the fund.**

14 **2. All fees authorized to be charged by the department shall be transmitted to the**
15 **department of revenue for deposit in the state treasury for credit to the fund, to be**
16 **disbursed solely for the payment of operating expenses of the bureau of narcotics and**
17 **dangerous drugs to conduct inspections, enforce controlled substances laws and**
18 **regulations, provide education to health care professionals and the public, and prevent**
19 **abuse of controlled substances.**

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.

18 **3. Any moneys appropriated or made available by gift, grant, bequest,**
19 **contribution, or otherwise to carry out the purposes of this section shall be paid to and**
20 **deposited in the controlled substance abuse prevention fund.**
