AN ACT

To amend chapter 191, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to pelvic examinations, with a penalty provision.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 191, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 191.240, to read as follows:

- 191.240. 1. A health care provider shall not knowingly perform a pelvic examination on a woman who is anesthetized or unconscious in a health care facility unless:
- 4 (1) The woman or a person authorized to make health care decisions for the woman 5 has given specific informed consent to the examination;
 - (2) The examination is necessary for diagnostic or treatment purposes; or
 - (3) A court orders the performance of the examination for the collection of evidence.
- 9 2. A health care provider who violates subsection 1 of this section is subject to discipline by any licensing board that licenses the health care provider.
