## **AN ACT**

To amend chapter 306, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to speed limits for watercraft.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 306, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 306.152, to read as follows:

306.152. 1. No person shall operate any watercraft at a speed in excess of a slow no-wake speed on a lake having at least one thousand miles of shoreline and owned and maintained by an electrical corporation during times when the lake elevation is six hundred sixty-one feet or greater and such elevation remains at that level for a minimum of four continuous hours. The no-wake restriction shall be lifted when the lake elevation is less than six hundred sixty-one feet for four continuous hours.

- 2. Lake elevation measurements shall be based on electrical corporation datum, collected at Bagnell Dam.
- 3. The department of public safety and the water patrol division of the state highway patrol may jointly issue a temporary no-wake order under the provisions of subsection 1 of this section during times when the lake elevation is under six hundred sixty-one feet for the immediate protection of life or property.
