AN ACT

To amend chapter 306, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to speed limits for watercraft.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 306, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 306.152, to read as follows:

306.152. 1. **No person shall operate any watercraft at a speed in excess of a slow
2 no-wake speed on a lake having at least one thousand miles of shoreline and owned and
3 maintained by an electrical corporation during times when the lake elevation is six
4 hundred sixty-one feet or greater and such elevation remains at that level for a minimum
5 of four continuous hours. The no-wake restriction shall be lifted when the lake elevation
6 is less than six hundred sixty-one feet for four continuous hours.**

7 2. **Lake elevation measurements shall be based on electrical corporation datum,
8 collected at Bagnell Dam.**

9 3. **The department of public safety and the water patrol division of the state
10 highway patrol may jointly issue a temporary no-wake order under the provisions of
11 subsection 1 of this section during times when the lake elevation is under six hundred sixty-
12 one feet for the immediate protection of life or property.**
