AN ACT

To amend chapter 188, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to reproductive health care services.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 188, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 188.345, to read as follows:

188.345. 1. For purposes of this section, the term "medically accurate and unbiased information" means information that is:

3 (1) Verified or supported by the weight of medical research conducted in 4 compliance with accepted scientific methods;

5 (2) Recognized as correct and objective by leading medical organizations with 6 relevant expertise or government agencies, such as the:

- 7 (a) American Academy of Family Physicians;
- 8 (b) American Academy of Pediatrics;
- 9 (c) American College of Physicians;
- 10 (d) American Congress of Obstetricians and Gynecologists;
- 11 (e) American Medical Association;
- 12 (f) American Psychological Association;
- 13 (g) American Public Health Association;
- 14 (h) Centers for Disease Control and Prevention;
- 15 (i) Food and Drug Administration;
- 16 (j) National Cancer Institute; or
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18 (k) National Institute for Health; or

19 (3) Recommended by or affirmed in the medical practice guidelines of a nationally
20 recognized accrediting organization, such as the:

- 21 (a) Joint Commission;
- 22 (b) National Committee for Quality Assurance (NCQA);

23 (c) American Accreditation HealthCare Commission or Utilization Review 24 Accreditation Commission (AAHC/URAC); or

(d) Accreditation Association for Ambulatory Health Care (AAAHC).

26 2. For purposes of this section, the term "pregnancy-related services" means 27 services including, but not limited to, family planning, abortion care, prenatal care, labor 28 and delivery, and postpartum care.

293. To be eligible to receive state funding, all organizations that provide pregnancy-30related services or counseling shall provide medically accurate and unbiased information

31 on all relevant reproductive health options including, but not limited to, information about

32 birth control, pregnancy, adoption, labor and delivery, and postpartum care.

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
