AN ACT

To amend chapter 227, RSMo, by adding thereto two new sections relating to memorial highway designations.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 227, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto two new sections, to be 2 known as sections 227.436 and 227.437, to read as follows:

227.436. The portion of U.S. Highway 63 from Breedlove Drive to Peabody Road
in Boone County shall be designated as "U.S. Army Specialist Steven Paul Farnen
Memorial Highway". The department of transportation shall erect and maintain
appropriate signs designating such highway, with costs to be paid by private donations.
227.437. The portion of U.S. Highway 63 from the interchange with Discovery
Parkway to Interstate 70 in Boone County shall be designated as "U.S. Navy Lieutenant

3 Patrick Kelly Connor Memorial Highway". The department of transportation shall erect

4 and maintain appropriate signs designating such highway, with costs to be paid by private
