AN ACT

To repeal section 321.320 as enacted by house bill no. 1446, ninety-ninth general assembly, second regular session, and section 321.320 as enacted by house bill no. 322, seventy-fifth general assembly, first regular session, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to fire protection districts, with an emergency clause.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 321.320 as enacted by house bill no. 1446, ninety-ninth general assembly, second regular session, and section 321.320 as enacted by house bill no. 322, seventy-fifth general assembly, first regular session, are repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 321.320, to read as follows:

[321.320. 1. Except as otherwise provided in this section, if any property, located within the boundaries of a fire protection district, is included 2 3 within a city having a population of forty thousand inhabitants or more, which 4 eity is not wholly within the fire protection district, and which eity maintains a 5 city fire department, the property is excluded from the fire protection district. 6 2. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, unless 7 otherwise approved by a majority vote of the governing body of the municipality and a majority vote of the governing body of the fire protection 8 9 district, or otherwise approved by a majority vote of the qualified voters in the 10 municipality and a majority vote of the qualified voters in the fire protection 11 district, a fire protection district serving an area included within any annexation by a municipality located in any county of the first classification 12 13 with more than one hundred fifty thousand but fewer than two hundred 14 thousand inhabitants, or an area included within any annexation by a 15 municipality in a county having a charter form of government, approved by a

16 vote after January 1, 2008, including simplified boundary changes, shall, 17 following the annexation: 18 (1) Continue to provide fire protection services, including emergency medical services to such area; 19 20 (2) Levy and collect any tax upon all taxable property included within 21 the annexed area authorized under chapter 321; 22 (3) Enforce any fire protection and fire prevention ordinances adopted 23 and amended by the fire protection district in such area. 24 3. All costs associated with placing an annexation on the ballot within 25 a municipality that involves an area that is served by a fire protection district 26 shall be borne by the municipality. 4. The provisions of subsections 2 and 3 of this section shall not apply 27 28 to: 29 (1) Any city of the third classification with more than four thousand five hundred but fewer than five thousand inhabitants and located in any 30 31 county with a charter form of government and with more than two hundred 32 thousand but fewer than three hundred fifty thousand inhabitants; 33 (2) Any city of the fourth classification with more than three thousand but fewer than three thousand seven hundred inhabitants and located in any 34 35 county with a charter form of government and with more than two hundred thousand but fewer than three hundred fifty thousand inhabitants; and 36 37 (3) Any city of the third classification with more than eleven thousand 38 five hundred but fewer than thirteen thousand inhabitants and located in any 39 county with a charter form of government and with more than two hundred 40 thousand but fewer than three hundred fifty thousand inhabitants. 41 5. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the residents of an area included within any annexation by a municipality located 42 in any county of the first elassification with more than one hundred fifty 43 44 thousand but fewer than two hundred thousand inhabitants, or an area included 45 within any annexation by a municipality in a county having a charter form of 46 government, approved by a vote after January 1, 2008, may vote in all fire 47 protection district elections and may be elected to the fire protection district 48 board of directors.]

321.320. **1. Except as otherwise provided in this section,** if any property, located within the boundaries of a fire protection district, is included within a city having a population of forty thousand inhabitants or more, which city is not wholly within the fire protection district, and which city maintains a city fire department, the property is excluded from the fire protection district.

6 2. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, unless otherwise 7 approved by a majority vote of the governing body of the municipality and a majority 8 vote of the governing body of the fire protection district, or otherwise approved by a 9 majority vote of the qualified voters in the municipality and a majority vote of the 10 qualified voters in the fire protection district, a fire protection district serving an area 11 included within any annexation by a municipality located in any county with more than HB 1961

12 one hundred fifty thousand but fewer than two hundred thousand inhabitants, or an 13 area included within any annexation by a municipality in a county with more than two 14 hundred thousand but fewer than two hundred thirty thousand inhabitants, including 15 simplified boundary changes, shall, following the annexation:

16 (1) Continue to provide fire protection services, including being solely 17 responsible for the management of incidents in such area including in the fire 18 protection district's sole discretion whether to use a single command structure, unified 19 command structure or to relinquish command to another agency in accordance with 20 written guidelines established by the fire protection district and including emergency 21 medical services to such area;

22 (2) Levy and collect any tax upon all taxable property included within the 23 annexed area authorized under chapter 321;

24 (3) Enforce any fire protection and fire prevention ordinances adopted and 25 amended by the fire protection district in such area.

26 **3.** All costs associated with placing an annexation on the ballot within a 27 municipality that involves an area that is served by a fire protection district shall be 28 paid by the municipality.

4. The provisions of subsections 2 and 3 of this section shall not apply to:

(1) Any city with more than four thousand four hundred but fewer than four
thousand nine hundred inhabitants and located in a county with more than two hundred
thousand but fewer than two hundred thirty thousand inhabitants;

33 (2) Any city with more than twelve thousand five hundred but fewer than
 34 fourteen thousand inhabitants and located in a county with more than two hundred
 35 thousand but fewer than two hundred thirty thousand inhabitants.

5. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the residents of an area included within any annexation by a municipality located in any county with more than one hundred fifty thousand but fewer than two hundred thousand inhabitants, or an area included within any annexation by a municipality in a county with more than two hundred thousand but fewer than two hundred thirty thousand inhabitants, may vote in all fire protection district elections and may be elected to the fire protection district board of directors.

Section B. Because immediate action is necessary to ensure the equal voting rights of persons residing in fire protection districts, section A of this act is deemed necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, welfare, peace, and safety, and is hereby declared to be an emergency act within the meaning of the constitution, and section A of this act shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval.
