AN ACT

To amend chapter 577, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to driving under the influence of marijuana.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 577, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 577.011, to read as follows:

2 **577.011. There shall be a permissible inference that a person is driving under the**
3 **influence of marijuana if, after an analysis of the person's blood, the blood contains five**
4 **nanograms or more of delta 9-tetrahydrocannabinol per milliliter. Nothing in this section**
shall be deemed to imply that possession and/or use of marijuana is legal in this state.
