AN ACT

To repeal section 57.317, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to sheriff salaries.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

- Section A. Section 57.317, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 57.317, to read as follows:
 - 57.317. 1. The [eounty] sheriff [in] of any county[5] other than [in] a [first classification chartered] charter county[5] shall receive an annual salary computed as follows:
 - (1) For counties of the first classification, a salary equal to ninety percent of the salary of the prosecuting attorney of the county; and
 - (2) For counties of the second, third, or fourth classification, as set forth in the following schedule. The assessed valuation factor shall be the amount thereof as shown for the year next preceding the computation. The provisions of this section shall not permit or require a reduction in the amount of compensation being paid for the office of sheriff on January 1, 1997.]:

The county assessed valuation factor shall be the amount thereof as shown for the year next preceding the computation. The provisions of this section shall not permit or require a reduction in the amount of compensation being paid for the office of sheriff on January 1, 1997.

- 2. Two thousand dollars of the salary authorized in this section shall be payable to the sheriff only if the sheriff has completed at least twenty hours of classroom instruction each calendar year relating to the operations of the sheriff's office when approved by a professional association of the county sheriffs of Missouri unless exempted from the training by the professional association. The professional association approving the program shall provide a certificate of completion to each sheriff who completes the training program and shall send a list of certified sheriffs to the treasurer of each county. Expenses incurred for attending the training session may be reimbursed to the county sheriff in the same manner as other expenses as may be appropriated for that purpose.
- 3. The [county] sheriff [in] of any county[5] other than a [first classification] charter county[5] shall not, except upon two-thirds vote of all the members of the salary commission, receive an annual compensation less than the total compensation being received for the office of county sheriff in the particular county for services rendered or performed on the date the salary commission votes.
