AN ACT

To amend chapter 407, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to actions affecting credit scores.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 407, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 407.1387, to read as follows:

407.1387. 1. For the purposes of this section, a "major life event" means a major event that changes a consumer's status or circumstances and includes marriage, divorce, and death of a spouse.

- 2. The act of closing a consumer's credit card account and opening a new credit card account in response to a major life event shall not affect the credit score of the consumer.
- 3. If a consumer's credit score is negatively affected by the action described under subsection 2 of this section, the consumer may inform a consumer credit reporting agency, and such consumer credit reporting agency shall inform all other consumer credit reporting agencies. Any consumer credit reporting agency that is informed that a consumer acted as described under subsection 2 of this section shall take the necessary measures so that the consumer's credit score is not affected by such actions.
