AN ACT

To amend chapter 67, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to gasoline filling station regulations in certain counties.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 67, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 67.058, to read as follows:

67.058. In any county of the third classification with more than fifteen thousand seven hundred but fewer than seventeen thousand six hundred inhabitants and with a county seat with more than two thousand but fewer than three thousand inhabitants, notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, the county governing body shall have the power and authority to regulate, license, and to establish and collect a license fee on gasoline filling stations and may, upon voter approval, by order issued by the governing body, base such license fee on a percentage or dollar amount per gallon of gasoline or diesel sold or on a percentage or dollar amount of the rate charged for use of electric charging stations per kilowatt-hour, if applicable.
