### AN ACT

To amend chapter 37, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to entrances to certain state offices, with penalty provisions.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 37, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 37.860, to read as follows:

2           **37.860. 1. The commissioner of the office of administration shall install, operate,**  
3 **and maintain an audio and visual recording of the main entrance to the official offices in**  
4 **the capitol building of the governor, lieutenant governor, speaker of the house of**  
5 **representatives, and president pro tempore of the senate. The recording shall be broadcast**  
6 **live on the internet and shall be archived for no less than seventy-five years. The method**  
7 **of archiving the recording shall allow for reproduction of specific time frames of video**  
8 **upon request.**

9           **2. The commissioner shall develop a request form to reproduce video, which shall**  
10 **be made available online and in print form. The actual cost of reproduction may be**  
11 **charged to the person requesting the video, but in no case shall such charge exceed ten**  
12 **dollars per hour of recording or parts thereof. The cost of installing, operating, and**  
13 **maintaining the audio and visual recordings required under this section shall be borne by**  
14 **and paid out of any funds appropriated to the office of administration.**

15           **3. Upon taking office, the governor, lieutenant governor, speaker of the house, and**  
16 **president pro tempore shall inform the commissioner of the location of the main entrance**  
17 **to their respective offices, which shall be changed only during each term in office upon**  
**application and approval of the commissioner.**

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.

18           **4. No registered lobbyist as defined in section 105.470 shall enter or exit the office**  
19 **of governor, lieutenant governor, speaker of the house, or president pro tempore except**  
20 **by the main entrance specified to the commissioner.**

21           **5. No registered lobbyist as defined in section 105.470 shall discuss any bill, law,**  
22 **contract, or bid for contract with the governor, lieutenant governor, speaker of the house,**  
23 **or president pro tempore unless such discussion takes place in such elected official's official**  
24 **office in the capitol building.**

25           **6. Any willful violation of this section by a registered lobbyist as defined in section**  
26 **105.470 shall be a class A misdemeanor. Any willful violation of this section by the**  
27 **governor, lieutenant governor, speaker of the house, or president pro tempore shall be**  
28 **cause for removal from office.**
