## AN ACT

To repeal section 34.030, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to land purchases made on behalf of departments of the state.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Section 34.030, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 34.030, to read as follows:

34.030. **1.** The commissioner of administration shall purchase all supplies for all departments of the state, except as in this chapter otherwise provided. The commissioner of administration shall negotiate all leases and purchase all lands, except for such departments as derive their power to acquire lands from the constitution of the state.

**2. For the purposes of the commissioner of administration purchasing lands on behalf of any department of the state that will be owned and managed by such department, the respective department shall:**

**(1) Provide public notice on its departmental website at least sixty days prior to the commissioner of administration purchasing such land on behalf of such state department;**

**(2) Provide public notice in every newspaper with a circulation of more than five hundred customers in every county in which the commissioner of administration intends to purchase private land on behalf of such state department. Such public notice shall appear weekly in such paper and shall appear for a minimum of nine weeks in such paper; and**

**(3) Hold a public hearing in every county in which the commissioner of administration intends to purchase private land on behalf of such state department. The department shall provide public notice of the public hearing on its departmental website**

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.

18 **at least fourteen calendar days prior to the hearing and in every newspaper in the county**  
19 **with a circulation of more than five hundred customers. The public notice shall appear**  
20 **weekly in such paper for a minimum of two weeks prior to the public hearing.**
