## AN ACT

To repeal section 485.060, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to compensation of court reporters.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 485.060, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu 2 thereof, to be known as section 485.060, to read as follows:

485.060. **1.** Each court reporter for a circuit judge shall receive an annual salary of twenty-six thousand nine hundred dollars beginning January 1, 1985, until December 31, 1985, and beginning January 1, 1986, until January 1, 2021, an annual salary of thirty thousand dollars. [Such] Beginning January 1, 2021, each court reporter for a circuit judge shall receive an annual salary based upon his or her cumulative years of service as a court reporter with a circuit court of this state, based upon the following schedule:

7 (1) Zero to five years of service: an annual salary shall be sixty thousand seventy 8 two dollars;

9 (2) Six to ten years of service: an annual salary shall be sixty-three thousand three 10 hundred twenty-two dollars;

(3) Eleven to fifteen years of service: an annual salary shall be sixty-eight thousand
three hundred twenty-two dollars;

(4) Sixteen to twenty years of service: an annual salary shall be seventy-three
thousand three hundred twenty-two dollars; and

(5) Twenty-one or more years of service: an annual salary shall be seventy-eight
thousand three hundred twenty-two dollars.

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.

17 **2.** An annual salary **pursuant to subsection 1 of this section** shall be modified by any 18 salary adjustment provided by section 476.405, payable in equal monthly installments on the 19 certification of the judge of the court or division in whose court the reporter is employed. When 20 paid by the state the salaries of such court reporters shall be paid in semimonthly or monthly 21 installments, as designated by the commissioner of administration.
