## **AN ACT**

To amend chapter 571, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to a reporting requirement for lost or stolen firearms, with penalty provisions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 571, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 571.065, to read as follows:

571.065. 1. An owner of a firearm shall report the loss or theft of the firearm within seventy-two hours of discovering the loss or theft to the local law enforcement agency in the city, town, or village or to the sheriff's office in the county in which the loss 4 or theft occurred. The local law enforcement agency or sheriff's office shall enter the make, model, and serial number of the firearm into the Missouri uniform law enforcement system (MULES).

- 2. Any person who fails to report the loss or theft of a firearm as required under this section shall, upon a plea or finding of guilt thereof, be:
  - (1) Given a warning for a first violation;
- (2) Guilty of an infraction punishable by a fine not to exceed one hundred dollars 10 for a second violation; 11
- 12 (3) Guilty of an infraction punishable by a fine not to exceed one thousand dollars 13 for a third violation; or
  - (4) Guilty of a class B misdemeanor for a fourth or subsequent violation.
