AN ACT

To amend chapter 301, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to a meritorious service medal special license plate.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 301, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 301.3159, to read as follows:

301.3159. Any person who has been awarded the military service award known as the meritorious service medal may apply for special motor vehicle license plates for any 2 motor vehicle such person owns, either solely or jointly, other than an apportioned motor 3 vehicle or a commercial motor vehicle licensed in excess of twenty-four thousand pounds 4 gross weight. Any such person shall make application for the special license plates on a 5 form provided by the director of revenue and furnish such proof as a recipient of the 6 meritorious service medal as the director may require. The director shall then issue license 7 plates bearing letters or numbers or a combination thereof as determined by the advisory 8 9 committee established in section 301.129, with the words "MERITORIOUS SERVICE" in place of the words "SHOW-ME STATE". Such license plates shall be made with fully 10 11 reflective material with a common color scheme and design, shall be clearly visible at night, and shall be aesthetically attractive, as prescribed by section 301.130. Such plates shall 12 also bear an image of the meritorious service medal. There shall be an additional fee 13 14 charged for each set of meritorious service license plates issued under this section equal to the fee charged for personalized license plates. There shall be no limit on the number of 15 16 license plates any person qualified under this section may obtain so long as each set of 17 license plates issued under this section is issued for vehicles owned solely or jointly by such
