AN ACT

To amend chapters 67 and 571, RSMo, by adding thereto two new sections relating to high-capacity magazines, with penalty provisions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapters 67 and 571, RSMo, are amended by adding thereto two new sections, to be known as sections 67.105 and 571.073, to read as follows:

67.105. No political subdivision shall issue or renew a business license for any entity cited for a violation of section 571.073.

571.073. 1. No entity shall sell or manufacture high-capacity magazines.

2. Any entity that sells or manufactures a high-capacity magazine shall be subject to a civil penalty in the amount of one hundred dollars per high-capacity magazine, not to exceed one thousand dollars per incident.

3. In addition to the penalties under subsection 2 of this section, the court shall direct the governing body of the applicable political subdivisions to revoke any current licenses or permits of the entity.

4. For the purposes of this section, "high-capacity magazine" shall include a magazine, belt, drum, feed strip, or similar device that has a capacity of, or that can be readily restored or converted to accept, more than ten rounds of ammunition, but does not include an attached tubular device designed to accept, and capable of operation only with, .22 caliber rimfire ammunition.
