### AN ACT

To amend chapter 32, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to digital driver's licenses.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 32, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 32.450, to read as follows:

32.450. 1. Notwithstanding any biometric data restrictions contained in section 302.170, the department of revenue is hereby authorized to design and implement a secure digital driver's license program that allows applicants applying for a driver's license in accordance with chapter 302 to obtain a secure digital driver's license in addition to the physical card-based driver's license.

6 2. (1) A digital driver's license issued under this section shall be acceptable for all 7 purposes for which a license, as defined in section 302.010, is used.

8 (2) The department may contract with one or more entities to develop the secure 9 digital driver's license system. The department or entity may develop a mobile software 10 application capable of being utilized through a person's electronic device to access an 11 electronic image of the person's secure digital driver's license.

(3) The department shall suspend, disable, or terminate a person's participation in
the secure digital driver's license program if:

14 (a) The person's driving privilege is suspended, revoked, denied, withdrawn, or 15 cancelled as provided in chapter 302; or

(b) The person reports that the person's electronic device has been lost, stolen, or
compromised.

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.

18 3. The department of revenue may promulgate rules necessary to implement the 19 provisions of this section. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section 20 536.010, that is created under the authority delegated in this section shall become effective 21 only if it complies with and is subject to all of the provisions of chapter 536 and, if 22 applicable, section 536.028. This section and chapter 536 are nonseverable, and if any of 23 the powers vested with the general assembly pursuant to chapter 536 to review, to delay 24 the effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently held 25 unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking authority and any rule proposed or adopted 26 after August 28, 2020, shall be invalid and void.
