## **AN ACT**

To amend chapter 67, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to taxing districts.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 67, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 67.5200, to read as follows:

67.5200. 1. For purposes of this section, the term "special taxing district" shall include all taxing districts that impose any tax under the laws of this state; however, 3 "special taxing district" shall not include the state or federal government, school districts, 4 fire protection districts, ambulance districts, or the government of any city or county in this state. "Special taxing districts" shall include, but not be limited to, community improvement districts, transportation development districts, tax increment financing districts, levee districts, library districts, port authority districts, and any other districts that impose a sales tax, property tax, or other tax assessment within their borders and jurisdiction, unless exempted under this subsection.

- 2. Every special taxing district in this state that is not otherwise required by statute to have an audit performed by a certified public accountant or other qualified auditor, or that does not have an audit performed in conjunction with the audit of its establishing or approving city or county, shall have an audit performed annually by an independent certified public accountant according to the provisions of this section.
- 3. Each special taxing district that is required to have an audit performed annually by an independent certified public accountant according to the provisions of this section shall individually select its own certified public accountant to perform such an audit, through a fair and competitive bidding process that considers no less than three bids and awards a contract to the lowest or best bidder. Contracts entered into under this

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- subsection may have a duration of up to five years. Upon the termination of an existing contract, a special taxing district shall hold a new fair and competitive bidding process to award a subsequent contract.
  - 4. Every certified public accountant performing an audit under this section shall compile his or her findings into a report that shall be submitted to the special taxing district that he or she audits, any county in which the special taxing district is located, any municipality in which the special taxing district is located, and the state auditor.
  - 5. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, special taxing districts may use a portion of the revenue received under their taxing authority to pay the fees and expenses arising under their contracts with certified public accountants to perform the audits required under this section.

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
