## AN ACT

To amend chapter 168, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to applications for a substitute certificate of license to teach.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 168, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 168.026, to read as follows:

3 **168.026. 1. An applicant for a substitute Missouri certificate of license to teach who**  
4 **has successfully completed a minimum of twenty clock hours of department-approved**  
5 **substitute teacher training that includes professionalism, honoring diversity, engaging**  
6 **students, foundational classroom management techniques, basic instructional strategies,**  
7 **supporting students with special needs, and working with at-risk youth may be granted a**  
8 **substitute Missouri certificate of license to teach under the rules promulgated by the state**  
9 **board of education.**

10 **2. This section shall expire on August 28, 2024.**
