AN ACT

To amend chapter 168, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to applications for a substitute certificate of license to teach.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 168, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 168.026, to read as follows:

168.026. 1. An applicant for a substitute Missouri certificate of license to teach who
has successfully completed a minimum of twenty clock hours of department-approved
substitute teacher training that includes professionalism, honoring diversity, engaging

- 4 students, foundational classroom management techniques, basic instructional strategies,
- 5 supporting students with special needs, and working with at-risk youth may be granted a
- 6 substitute Missouri certificate of license to teach under the rules promulgated by the state
- 7 board of education.
