### AN ACT

To amend chapter 162, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the rights of children with disabilities.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 162, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 162.702, to read as follows:

162.702. 1. A private school that is contacted by the parents or guardians of any
child for purposes of enrolling their child in the private school shall provide the parents
or guardians of the child with the informational materials described in subsection 2 of this
section at least one day before the child officially enrolls in the private school.

5 2. The department of elementary and secondary education shall develop the 6 informational materials to be provided to parents or guardians under subsection 1 of this 7 section and post the materials on its website. The informational materials shall:

8 (1) Describe the state's obligation under the Individuals with Disabilities Education 9 Act (IDEA) to ensure a free appropriate public education in the least restrictive 10 environment is made available to all eligible children with disabilities and summarize how 11 the courts have interpreted this obligation;

(2) Explain that if parents or guardians of a child with a disability decide to enroll
 their child in a private school, the child is considered a parentally placed private school
 child under the IDEA and does not have the right to a free appropriate public education;

(3) Describe the level of services and due process rights required under the IDEA
 for a child with a disability enrolled in a public school in comparison to the level of services
