## AN ACT

To amend chapter 590, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to arrest notifications.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 590, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 590.1275, to read as follows:

**590.1275. 1. If any person is arrested for a misdemeanor or felony offense, the  
2 law enforcement agency making the arrest shall, within twenty-four hours of such  
3 arrest, notify the arrested person's parent or legal guardian if he or she is under  
4 eighteen years of age or, if the arrested person is eighteen years of age or older, notify the  
5 person's designated contact.**

**6 2. For purposes of this section, "designated contact" means an individual  
7 identified by the arrested person for the limited purpose of arrest notification under this  
8 section. A designated contact shall be eighteen years of age or older.**
