## AN ACT

To repeal section 9.010, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to public holidays.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Section 9.010, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu  
2 thereof, to be known as section 9.010, to read as follows:

9.010. The first day of January, the third Monday of January, the twelfth day of  
2 February, the third Monday in February, the eighth day of May, the last Monday in May, **the**  
3 **nineteenth day of June**, the fourth day of July, the first Monday in September, the second  
4 Monday in October, the eleventh day of November, the fourth Thursday in November, and the  
5 twenty-fifth of December, are declared and established public holidays; and when any of such  
6 holidays falls upon Sunday, the Monday next following shall be considered the holiday.  
7 There shall be no holiday for state employees on the fourth Monday of October.
