AN ACT

To amend chapter 302, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to traffic violations.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 302, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 302.335, to read as follows:

3 **302.335. 1. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 2 of this section, any**
4 **motorist charged with a traffic violation in this state or any county or municipality of this**
5 **state shall receive notification, in person, within twenty-four hours of the violation from**
6 **a law enforcement officer employed by the law enforcement agency issuing the violation.**

7 **2. The in-person notification requirement of subsection 1 of this section shall not**
8 **apply to:**

- 9 **(1) Parking tickets;**
- 10 **(2) Violations under section 577.060;**
- (3) Incidents requiring further investigation; or**
- (4) Any other situation in which in-person notification is not possible.**
