AN ACT

To amend chapters 640 and 644, RSMo, by adding thereto two new sections relating to water quality.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapters 640 and 644, RSMo, are amended by adding thereto two new 2 sections, to be known as sections 640.450 and 644.300, to read as follows:

640.450. 1. The department of natural resources shall adopt rules establishing a
voluntary water pollutant trading program available to both point and nonpoint sources
discharging to surface waters. This voluntary program shall offer flexibility to the fullest
extent permitted under federal law.

5 2. The department shall develop a procedure to facilitate water pollutant trading 6 consistent with National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) requirements. 7 For point sources, all trading shall be addressed in NPDES permits. For nonpoint sources, 8 the department of natural resources shall work cooperatively with the department of 9 agriculture to develop a certification program for nonpoint source generated credits to be 10 used by nonpoint sources and within the NPDES program.

3. The department of natural resources may promulgate rules and regulations to implement the provisions of this section. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section 536.010, that is created under the authority delegated in this section shall become effective only if it complies with and is subject to all of the provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section 536.028. This section and chapter 536 are nonseverable, and if any of the powers vested with the general assembly pursuant to chapter 536 to review, to delay the effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently held
