AN ACT

To repeal section 575.353, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof two new sections relating to offenses against police animals, with penalty provisions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 575.353, RSMo, is repealed and two new sections enacted in lieu 2 thereof, to be known as sections 575.353 and 575.354, to read as follows:

575.353. 1. A person commits the offense of assault on a police animal if he or she knowingly attempts to kill or disable or knowingly causes or attempts to cause serious physical injury to a police animal when that animal is involved in law enforcement investigation, apprehension, tracking, or search, or the animal is in the custody of or under the control of a law enforcement officer, department of corrections officer, municipal police department, fire department or a rescue unit or agency.

2. The offense of assault on a police animal is a class [C] A misdemeanor, unless the
assault results in the death of such animal or disables such animal to the extent it is unable to
be utilized as a police animal, in which case it is a class E felony.

3. A person convicted of the offense of assault on a police animal shall make
restitution for injuries caused to the police animal and shall pay the replacement cost of
the animal if, as a result of the offense, the animal can no longer perform the animal's
duties.

575.354. 1. A person commits the offense of harassment of a police animal if a 2 person intentionally, knowingly, or maliciously harasses, teases, or interferes with or 3 attempts to interfere with a police animal while the animal is in the performance of the 4 animal's duties.

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.
