### **AN ACT**

To amend chapter 9, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to tardive dyskinesia awareness week.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 9, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 9.289, to read as follows:

9.289. 1. The first full week in May each year shall be known and designated as 2 "Tardive Dyskinesia Awareness Week". Tardive dyskinesia is a movement disorder that 3 is characterized by random, involuntary, and uncontrolled movements of different 4 muscles in the face, trunk, and extremities. The citizens of this state are encouraged to 5 observe the week with appropriate events and activities to raise awareness of tardive 6 dyskinesia. 7

2. The provisions of this section shall expire on August 28, 2026.

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
