## AN ACT

To amend chapter 569, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the offense of burglary in the third degree, with a penalty provision.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 569, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 569.172, to read as follows:

3 **569.172. 1. A person commits the offense of burglary in the third degree if the**  
4 **person unlawfully enters a motor vehicle for the purpose of appropriating movable**  
5 **property of another and takes possession of, carries away, or exercises unlawful control**  
6 **over, or attempts to take possession of, carry away, or exercise unlawful control over,**  
7 **such movable property of another from the motor vehicle.**

8 **2. The offense of burglary in the third degree is a class E felony.**
