AN ACT

To amend chapter 569, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the offense of burglary in the third degree, with a penalty provision.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 569, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 569.172, to read as follows:

569.172. 1. A person commits the offense of burglary in the third degree if the

2 person unlawfully enters a motor vehicle for the purpose of appropriating movable

3 property of another and takes possession of, carries away, or exercises unlawful control

4 over, or attempts to take possession of, carry away, or exercise unlawful control over,

5 such movable property of another from the motor vehicle.

2. The offense of burglary in the third degree is a class E felony.
