## **AN ACT**

To repeal section 21.520, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to unfunded policy changes.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 21.520, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 21.520, to read as follows:

21.520. **1.** Beginning July 1, 1978, all departments of state government and each government entity operating programs for which appropriations are made shall provide the oversight division of the committee on legislative research and the appropriations committees

of the house and senate with the following information on a monthly basis: Expenditures by

5 account number assigned by the office of administration, division of accounting, in the chart of

6 accounts and index for fiscal year 1979 appropriations and each fiscal year thereafter; federal

7 fund expenditures by grant and purpose together with the public law number authorizing such

8 expenditures and the grant identifier number; notification of termination of any federal grant and

9 disposition of any employees employed under such grant. In the event state funds are

10 appropriated for purposes for which a federal grant is anticipated and the grant is not made, such

state funds may not be used for other purposes. In the event federal funds are terminated during

federal fiscal year 1979 and each fiscal year thereafter, state funds appropriated to match such

federal funds may not be used for other purposes and the state funds shall lapse if not used for

14 their designated purpose.

2. Beginning August 28, 2018, all departments of state government and each government entity operating programs for which appropriations are made shall include in its report under subsection 1 of this section if a change in policy negatively affected

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18 revenue collections to a fund dedicated for use by the department or government entity or

- 19 positively affected the regular expenditures of the department or government entity. Each
- 20 January, a department or government entity shall request the appropriation committees
- 21 of the house and senate to appropriate an amount of general revenue to compensate the

22 department or government entity for such changes in policy.

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
