AN ACT

To amend chapter 26, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the governor.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 26, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 26.230, to read as follows:

2 **26.230. 1. The governor shall use state vehicles or airplanes for any travel required**
3 **for official business. For the purposes of this section "official business" shall include any**
4 **travel that is undertaken in the furtherance of the governor's duties under the constitution**
5 **and laws of Missouri.**

6 **2. When the governor is traveling on unofficial business, he or she shall notify the**
7 **lieutenant governor of such unofficial business travel. If the governor's unofficial business**
8 **travel includes private or commercial flights, the governor shall inform the lieutenant**
9 **governor of the name of the airline or pilot, the make and model of the plane, and the party**
10 **responsible for safety and maintenance of the plane.**
