AN ACT

To amend chapter 640, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to signage on public boat ramps.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 640, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 640.650, to read as follows:

- 640.650. 1. This section shall be known and may be cited as "Marie's Law".**
- 2. The department of natural resources shall place clear and conspicuous signage at the following state-owned boat ramps in the Lake of the Ozarks State Park:**
- (1) Public Beach #1;**
 - (2) Grand Glaize Beach, also known as Public Beach #2;**
 - (3) McCubbins Point; and**
 - (4) Pa He Tsi.**
- 3. The signage shall read: "Marie's Message: Stay Afloat, Don't Drink and Boat".**
