AN ACT

To amend chapter 167, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to student behavior in schools.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 167, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 167.189, to read as follows:

3 **167.189. 1. A student who purports to be an imaginary animal or animal species**
4 **or who engages in anthropomorphic behavior consistent with the common designation**
5 **of a "furry" while at school shall not be allowed to participate in school curriculum or**
6 **activities. The parent or guardian of a student in violation of this section shall remove**
7 **the student from the school for the remainder of the school day.**

2. This section shall apply for the 2024-25 school year and all subsequent school
7 years.
