## AN ACT

To amend chapter 172, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to instructional waivers at the University of Missouri.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 172, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 172.103, to read as follows:

172.103. 1. For purposes of this section, the following terms mean:

2 (1) "Regular faculty member", a faculty member with full-time service carrying 3 full-time pay who has been granted tenure or is in a tenure-track position;

4 (2) "Section credit", the number of credits a semester-long course is worth for the 5 purposes of graduation;

6 (3) "Student credit hours", the number of section credits for a course multiplied 7 by the number of students enrolled in such course.

8 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no regular faculty member shall be 9 assigned a teaching load that is fewer than twelve section credits or fewer than one 10 hundred eighty student credit hours per academic year without an instructional waiver. 11 The number of instructional waivers granted for each campus of the University of Missouri 12 shall not exceed the average number of instructional waivers granted by member 13 institutions of the Association of American Universities, plus five percent.
