AN ACT

To amend chapter 167, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to public school athletic contests.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 167, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 167.177, to read as follows:

167.177. 1. To ensure fair competition in interscholastic athletic contests organized by publicly funded secondary schools, it is the public policy of this state that students who attend a publicly funded secondary school and participate in athletic contests organized by the school should participate in athletic contests organized for persons of the same biological sex included on the student's original birth certificate.

9 (1) A biologically female student may participate in an athletic contest organized 10 for females, males, or both sexes;

(2) A biologically male student may participate in an athletic contest organized for
males or both sexes;

(3) A transgender male student who is transitioning or has transitioned from female
to male and who has not taken hormone therapy to transition may participate in an athletic
contest organized for females, males, or both sexes;

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.

(4) A transgender male student who is transitioning or has transitioned from female
