AN ACT

To amend chapter 238, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the I-70 regional transportation district.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 238, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 238.290, to read as follows:

238.290. 1. There is hereby created the "I-70 Regional Transportation District", 2 which shall comprise areas in an interstate corridor of:

3 (1) Any county with a population greater than twelve thousand two hundred thirty
4 and less than twelve thousand three hundred;

5 (2) Any county with a population greater than seventeen thousand six hundred and 6 less than eighteen thousand;

7 (3) Any county of the fourth classification with a population greater than twenty-8 three thousand three hundred and less than twenty-three thousand four hundred;

9 (4) Any county with a population greater than thirty-two thousand five hundred 10 and less than thirty-five thousand;

(5) Any county with a population greater than forty-four thousand three hundred
 and less than forty-five thousand;

13 (6) Any county with a population greater than one hundred sixty thousand and less
14 than two hundred thousand;

15 (7) Any county with a population greater than three hundred fifty thousand and 16 less than four hundred thousand; or

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.

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17 (8) Any county with a charter form of government and with more than six hundred 18 thousand but fewer than seven hundred thousand inhabitants.

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20 The district may fund, promote, plan, design, construct, improve, maintain, and operate 21 one or more projects or assist in such activity. The district shall be a political subdivision 22 of the state. Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary, sections 238.200 to 238.280 23 shall apply to the district.

24 2. The I-70 regional transportation district shall be governed by a board. The 25 board shall comprise three members from each county in the district. The governing body 26 of each county shall decide the method of selection and term of office of its board members.

27 3. If approved by a majority of the qualified voters voting on the question in the I-28 70 regional transportation district, the district may charge and collect a tax or fee in the 29 district to provide matching funds for projects concerning the construction, expansion, or 30 maintenance of Interstate 70, its service roads, its bypasses, or its interchanges.

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4. The ballot of submission shall be substantially in the following form:

43 5. For the purpose of federal funds, projects of the I-70 regional transportation 44 district shall take priority over other projects in the state.

45 6. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no toll shall be charged or collected for the access or use of Interstate 70 by the I-70 regional transportation district; the 46 47 department of transportation or any of its partners, contractors, or agents; or any other 48 agency or entity.
