# HOUSE BILL NO. 2832

### AN ACT

To repeal section 386.050, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the members of the public service commission.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 386.050, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu 2 thereof, to be known as section 386.050, to read as follows:

386.050. The commission shall consist of [five] seven members who shall be 2 appointed by the governor, with the advice and consent of the senate, provided that no more 3 than one of whom shall be appointed from any congressional district and one of whom 4 shall be designated by the governor to be chair of the commission. At least one member 5 shall have experience in finance, at least one member shall have experience in the utility 6 sector, and at least two members shall have been engaged in farming, as defined in section 350.010. Each commissioner, at the time of the commissioner's appointment and 7 qualification, shall be a resident of the state of Missouri, and shall have resided in the state for 8 9 a period of at least five years next preceding the appointment and qualification, and shall also be a qualified voter therein and not less than twenty-five years of age. Upon the expiration of 10 11 each of the terms of office of the first commissioners, the term of office of each commissioner 12 thereafter appointed shall be six years from the time of the commissioner's appointment and qualification and until his successor shall qualify. Vacancies in the commission shall be filled 13 14 by the governor for the unexpired term.

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EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.

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
