AN ACT

To amend chapter 34, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to contracts with certain countries.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 34, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 34.605, to read as follows:

- 34.605. 1. No public or private entity receiving public funds shall enter into a contract with Russia, Russian entities, or any other country adversely occupying or attacking a North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) member, Ukraine, Finland, Sweden, or Georgia; except that, nothing in this section shall apply to transactions authorized under Ukraine General License Number 18 issued on February 21, 2022, by the Office of Foreign Assets Control of the United States Department of the Treasury.
 - 2. As used in this section, the following terms mean:
 - (1) "Private entity", any for-profit or not-for-profit organization, association, corporation, partnership, joint venture, limited partnership, limited liability partnership, limited liability company, sole proprietorship, or other entity or business association, including all wholly owned subsidiaries, majority-owned subsidiaries, parent companies, or affiliates of those entities or business associations that receives any public funding;
 - (2) "Public entity", the state of Missouri, or any political subdivision thereof, including all boards, commissions, agencies, institutions, authorities, and bodies politic and corporate of the state, created by or in accordance with state law or regulations;

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- partnership, limited liability partnership, limited liability company, sole proprietorship,
- or other entity or business association, including all wholly owned subsidiaries,

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- 21 majority-owned subsidiaries, parent companies, or affiliates of those entities or business
- 22 associations organized under the laws of Russia.
 - 3. Any contract that fails to comply with the provisions of this section shall be void against public policy.
- 4. The commissioner of administration or his or her designee may promulgate regulations to implement the provisions of this section so long as they are consistent with this section and do not create any exceptions. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section 536.010, that is created under the authority of this section shall become effective only if it complies with and is subject to all of the provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section 536.028. This section and chapter 536 are nonseverable and if any of the powers vested with the general assembly pursuant to chapter 536, to review, to delay the effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently 32 33 held unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking authority and any rule proposed or adopted after August 28, 2022, shall be invalid and void.
