# **HOUSE BILL NO. 3008**

### 101ST GENERAL ASSEMBLY

3008H.06T 2022

### AN ACT

To appropriate money for the expenses, grants, refunds, and distributions of the Department of Public Safety and the several divisions and programs thereof, to be expended only as provided in Article IV, Section 28 of the Constitution of Missouri, and to transfer money among certain funds for the period beginning July 1, 2022, and ending June 30, 2023.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

There is appropriated out of the State Treasury, to be expended only as provided in 2 Article IV, Section 28 of the Constitution of Missouri, for the purpose of funding each

- department, division, agency, fund transfer, and program described herein for the item or items
- 4 stated, and for no other purpose whatsoever, chargeable to the fund designated, for the period
- 5 beginning July 1, 2022, and ending June 30, 2023, as follows:
