AN ACT

To appropriate money for the expenses, grants, refunds, distributions, purchase of equipment, planning expenses, capital improvement projects, including but not limited to major additions and renovation of facility components, and equipment or systems for the several departments and offices of state government and the several divisions and programs thereof, and to transfer money among certain funds, to be expended only as provided in Article IV, Section 28 of the Constitution of Missouri for the fiscal period beginning July 1, 2022, and ending June 30, 2023.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

- There is appropriated out of the State Treasury, to be expended only as provided in 2 Article IV, Section 28 of the Constitution of Missouri, for the purpose of funding each
- 3 department, division, agency, fund transfer, and program described herein for the item or items
- 4 stated, and for no other purpose whatsoever, chargeable to the fund designated for the period
- 5 beginning July 1, 2022 and ending June 30, 2023, as follows:

The amount(s) in the appendix will not be considered an addition to any ongoing core appropriation(s) in future fiscal periods beyond June 30, 2023. The amount(s) in the appendix may, however, be requested in any future fiscal period as a new decision item.
