AN ACT

To amend chapter 476, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to equipment capable of retaining audio from trial or other court proceedings.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 476, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 476.012, to read as follows:

2 **476.012. By January 1, 2019, each court in this state shall be required to phase in**
2 **equipment that allows such court to retain audio recordings from trial or other court**
3 **proceedings for a minimum of one year.**
