AN ACT

To amend chapter 141, RSMo, by adding thereto two new sections relating to public health.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 141, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto two new sections, to be known as sections 141.239 and 141.241, to read as follows:

141.239. 1. Beginning August 28, 2018, the following requirements on vaccines shall apply:

- (1) For herpes zoster, commonly known as shingles, vaccines, only vaccines that produce the highest available immune response and that contain no foreign human DNA contaminants shall be administered to patients in public health clinics in Missouri; and
- (2) For varicella, commonly known as chicken pox, vaccines, only vaccines that contain no foreign human DNA contaminants shall be administered to patients in public health clinics in Missouri.
- 141.241. The Missouri Autism and Developmental Disabilities Monitoring Project of the Center for Disease Control and Prevention shall annually report on autistic and developmentally disabled children of four and eight years of age.
