### AN ACT

To amend chapter 217, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the provision of nutraloaf in correctional centers.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 217, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 217.153, to read as follows:

217.153. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, a correctional center shall not 2 use nutraloaf, prison loaf, or other form of bread as a disciplinary tool. For purposes of

3 this section, "nutraloaf" or "prison loaf" means a food product made from various

4 ingredients mixed together, baked in a loaf, and served to offenders who have

5 misbehaved instead of normal meals.
