### **AN ACT**

To amend chapter 34, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to state entity flower purchases.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 34, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 34.078, to read as follows:

34.078. 1. This section shall be known and may be cited as the "Missouri Grown 2 Flowers Act".

- 2. As used in this section, the following terms mean:
- 4 (1) "Commissioner", the commissioner of the office of administration;
- 5 (2) "Cut flower", any flower removed from a living plant for decorative use;
- 6 (3) "Cut green", any green, foliage, or branch removed from a living plant for decorative use:
- 8 (4) "Public agency", the state of Missouri; its legislative and judicial branches; its 9 departments, agencies, boards, commissions, and institutions; and all political subdivisions thereof, including school districts.
- 3. (1) No public agency shall purchase a cut flower or a cut green unless the cut flower or cut green is produced in this state.
- 13 (2) If a cut flower or cut green to be purchased by the public agency is unavailable 14 from any producer in this state, the public agency may purchase a cut flower or a cut green 15 from a producer in the United States.
- 4. The commissioner shall compile a list of Missouri cut flower and cut green producers and provide access to such list to all public agencies and other interested parties.

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.
